PIH-supported facilities prevent, diagnose, and treat disease, delivering care and contributing to strengthening health systems.

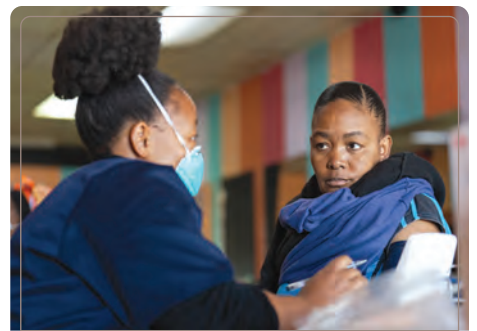

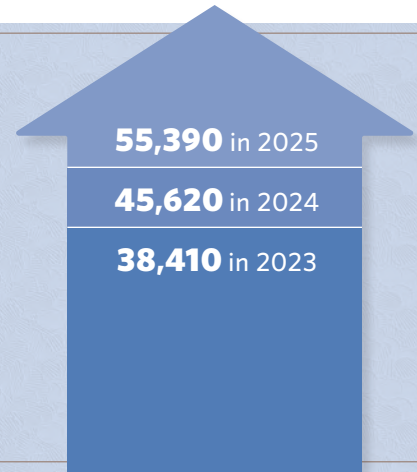

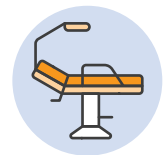

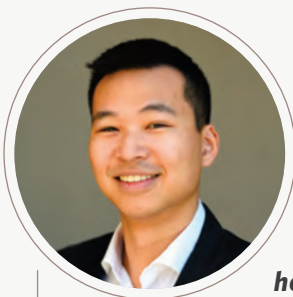
